

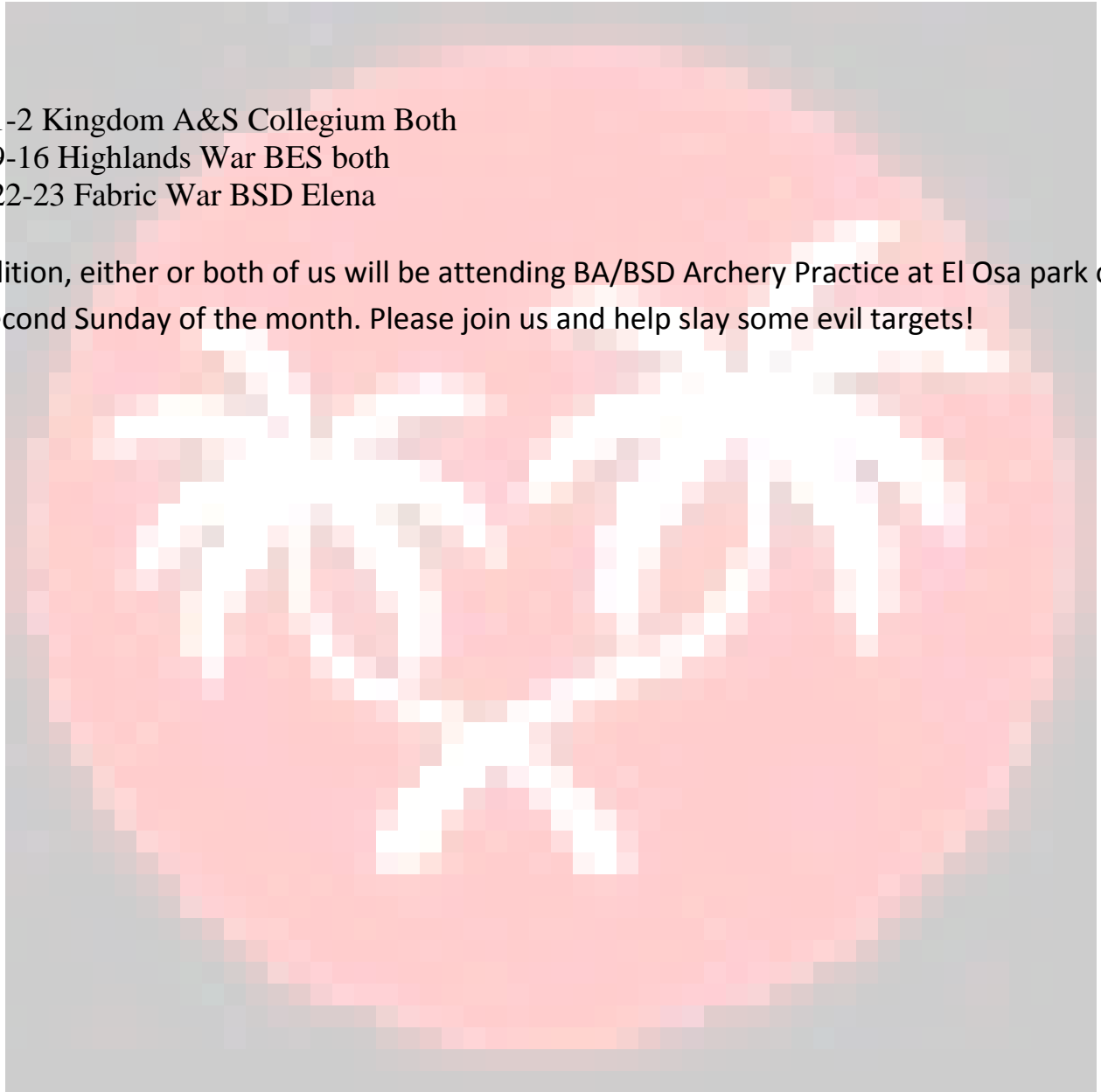

SUBMISSIONS ACCEPTED UNTIL SEPTEMBER 1, 2013

We are now accepting submissions for the 2013 issue of the Atenveldtus Glorious, the Arts and Sciences issue of the Southwind.

As many of you know, the Atenveldtus Glorious has moved to Google Sites, an online format. In order to be able to faithfully recreate your hard work, we are asking that you provide your submissions in the format that is requested. Your articles would resemble the sample below:

Text:

Black work was very prominent in the 16 th century, particularly during the late 1500's. Many articles of clothing were done with black work. Below is an example of some styles of black work. (Insert blkwrk1.jpg and blkwrk2.jpg)

You would then send your text file AND your image files (blkwrk1.jpg, blkwrk2.jpg) separately .

Alternately, if you have many pictures, you could put them in a zip file. In any case, you can send them through email , or put them on a CD and snail mail. Also, if you are doing a "HOW-TO" with a lot of pictures, consider doing a video. We will record it for you.

The best submission format for articles is the above format, as it makes the preparations much easier for the web editor, and it makes it a lot quicker to create your article as a web page.

A permission form is required. Please open Kingdom site, open A&S and go to Atenveldt Glorious page. There you will find submission guidelines. Click on the permission form under the "Welcome" paragraph or if you are snail-mailing click on the PDF Permission form. You only need ONE form no matter how many submissions you are making.

All submissions and permission forms will first come to Dame Fiona. I would prefer receiving articles in Word wherever possible. It is easier for me to download and edit before it is sent to the web editor.
